Miracles are reserved for other people, not me. Where do you think that line of thinking comes from? Those are the geese that are squawking at us! We have a tendency to view God through conditional glasses, meaning if I do this then He will do that. I would like to challenge you this week to ask God to reveal Himself to you, I dare you.

Monday

Read Psalm 18:19. Take a piece of paper and write that verse out. Put it somewhere where you can read it everyday. Let those words from God sink into your soul. Do you believe that God delights in you? How does that show up in your daily life? In your list, is there anything there that is based on you doing something for Him? Do you believe that God can just simply delight in you? Read Psalm 139:1-18. Ask God to “woo” you this week. I know it sounds weird but don’t worry, He understands.

Tuesday

Read John 4:1-42. Who do you relate to most in the story? If Jesus were to meet you at your “well” today, what do you think He would say to you? Jesus took several days out of the disciples “schedule” and stayed with the Samaritans. Read John 15:1-11. What does it mean for you to abide in Christ? Is there something that could possibly be keeping you from abiding in Him?

Wednesday

Read John 9. When something unexpected or perhaps even bad happens in your life, what is your initial reaction? The disciples thought that there was something that this man had done to deserve this fate. Do you see your life as something that God could use to bring honor to Him? How does intimacy with Him play into our seeing His purpose for our lives? Read Jeremiah 33:3. Is there something in your past or present that you need to call out to God? It’s ok if you do, He can handle it and wants your relationship with Him to be real.

Thursday

Read John 8:1-11. What do you think was running through that woman’s mind as she was brought before Jesus? Have you ever felt that way? How did grace change this woman’s life? How has it changed yours? I believe that God changes more lives with grace instead of condemnation. Who needs grace in your life today?
