Read Hebrews 4:14-16. What response do you have to the thought that Jesus knows what it feels like to be tempted by what tempts you? What do you need to bring before the throne of grace today? In what ways do you need God to be merciful to you this week, this day, this hour, and this minute? May you always know that God is near and is waiting for you to draw near to him!

### **Tuesday**

Read Hebrews 7:23-25. What does it mean that Jesus is our permanent priest? He is ready and willing to make daily intercession for you before the father. What do you bring before the Father today? Ask Jesus to lead you in his will and plan for your life and our church! May his complete salvation bring you peace and direction as you seek his heart!

### **Wednesday**

Read Hebrews 10:22-23. What does it mean to draw near to God with a sincere heart? What relationship is there between drawing near to God and having a clean heart? When was the last time you drew near to God with this kind of sincerity? What about today...now? He has opened wide the pathway to seek him and listen as he speaks his will to us. May you seek him with a sincere and clean heart that you might find yourself in his will and under his blessing because he is faithful!

### **Thursday**

Read Hebrews 10:25. Why would the writer of Hebrews put such a priority on meeting together? How have others encouraged you to draw near to God throughout your Christian life? How can you spur someone on to love and good deeds today? My brothers and sisters, we are all in this together and may we never forget how much we need each other!
