Jeff Carnie, our Contemporary Worship Pastor, and his team of accomplished musicians are committed to creating an energetic environment that encourages freedom of expression, adding to the authenticity of worship. At 11:15am, you'll find our "Passion" service; where passion meets purpose. Think contemporary rock... drums, electric guitars and high energy, yet, mixed with times of acoustic reflection. This late morning service, led by Pastor Joel Neufeld and his team of devoted musicians, is designed to evoke a time of guitar-driven praise in a relaxed and informal environment. 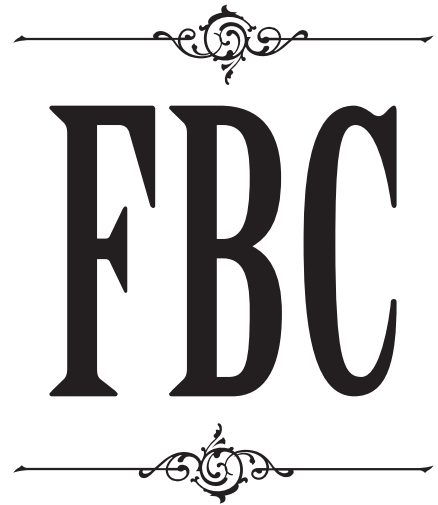
