The petition is to request that an initiative to strengthen human trafficking laws be placed on the California Ballot. It includes the following:

- Increased jail time of traffickers of *minors* to 15 years to life; and up to a \$500K fine
- Increased jail time for traffickers of *adults* to 6, 12, or 16 years; and up to \$300K fine for forced sex trafficking/labor/service
- Increased victim's rights including a longer time to bring civil suit against traffickers
- Distribution of trafficker's forfeited assets/fines to victim's services and community organizations
- Mandatory 2-hour human trafficking training for law enforcement

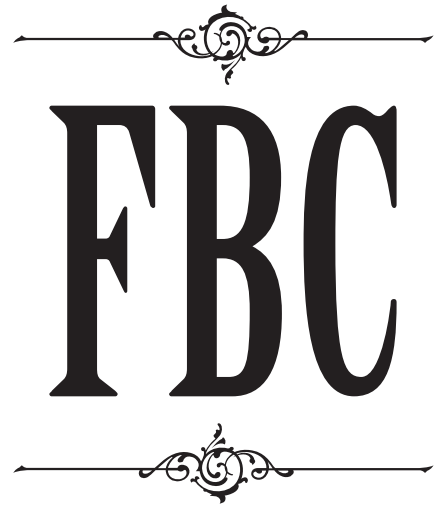
